THE FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY

Sheila shared with the consultant before the meeting that she'd already typed out a resignation letter. She hated the new hospital CEO, who had terrorized everyone, and even though she was willing to attend the weekend retreat for the hospital's executive staff, she was leaving. With no time to process her feelings, the consultant prayed to be guided by a source of wisdom wider than his own. He began with an exercise in transparency, asking each of the executives to name their greatest fear.

Amazingly, the CEO spoke first, "I know I've been really rough on you since I came on board," he confessed, sharing that his reason was a fear of failure. Revealing his vulnerability opened the team to participation that succeeded beyond expectations. As the end of the weekend neared, the consultant asked them to conclude by sharing how each person had been a gift to the hospital and a gift to them personally.

The CEO and Sheila were seated together. "Sheila," he said, "you are God's gift to this hospital because you are ready to take on any task that comes, and do it with excellence and thoroughness." He stated she was a shining example of someone who truly cared about the patients, concluding, "You have been a gift to me because no matter what is going on, or how upset I got with everyone, you always maintained a sense of calm and joy. As soon as you walked into any setting, I knew that light and fairness had come to the situation."

As recorded in an article by Laurie Beth Jones in *Chicken Soup for the Soul: Stories for a Better World*, the story reveals an epiphany shared by two individuals. Epiphany is the sudden perception of the essential nature of something. If God's essential nature could be realized through honest open sharing, "then you shall be radiant at what you see, your heart shall throb and overflow."

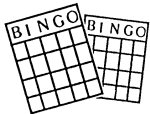
